The Kennard-Dale Ram's Girls Lacrosse team defeated Exeter Township by the final score 12-8 on May 26, 2016 to win the District III Girls' Lacrosse Championship.

On June 1st, the team defeated Pine-Richland in the first round of the PIAA State Championship tournament at Cumberland Valley High School by the final

score of 12-9. In the quarterfinal game on June 4th, they ended their run against Conestoga at Avon Grove High School.

The District III Championship trophy will be displayed in the Kennard-Dale trophy cases located outside the Kennard-Dale cafeteria.

KENNARD-DALE POWERLIFT TEAM WINS THE RAW TEAM STATE POWERLIFTING CHAMPIONSHIP!

K-D's Powerlifting Team won the 2016 P.S.C.P.A. RAW Team State Powerlifting Championship on April 30th at Glen Mills Schools in Concordville, PA. Members of KD's team competed in their respective divisions against 5 other teams from around the state. K-D won their 3rd State Title over teams from Forrest Hills, Salisbury High School (Allentown), Shamokin, Cheltenham, and Central York. Other schools K-D competed against this year that had lifters represented in the RAW division were: Glen Mills, Abington, and York Suburban. Nearly 200 high school lifters from all over Pennsylvania competed at this year's state event.

The RAW category the K-D Rams compete in is for lifters who choose to just wear a supportive belt during the contest. K-D team members were Destiny DeLara, Julia Markley, Madeline Armeni, Noah Hulslander, Danny Eagle, Jake Devereaux, Dalton Stike, Sam Gordon, Jonathan Rineholt, Ryan McNutt, Marc Partee, Matt Mercer, Brian White, and Zack McFatridge.

Individuals that won their respective divisions and claim individual State Championships were: Danny Eagle (148 JV), Ryan McNutt (198 V), Marc Partee (242 V), Matt Mercer (242 JV), and Zack McFatridge (SHW JV). Jake Devereaux, Ryan McNutt, Marc Partee, and Zack McFatridge also set New PA State Records during the event.

Earlier this year, K-D's Powerlifting Team came up just short and placed 3rd at a team competition at Parkland High School in Allentown. Afterwards, they were motivated and trained hard in order to focus their efforts on winning the State Title. The Rams proved that their skills and effort would not be denied. Future goals for the team will be to qualify lifters to attend the USA Powerlifting National High School Championship in 2017 which will be held in Scranton, PA.



SECEF MINI GRANT BENEFITS SOUTH EASTERN, GUATEMALA & URUGUAY SCHOOLS



South Eastern Community Education Foundation (SECEF) awarded one of its mini-grants for the 2015-2016 school year to Karen Snyder, a Spanish teacher at Kennard-Dale High School. Mrs. Snyder's Spanish IV and V students created colorful jigsaw puzzles that incorporated vocabulary words. They sent the puzzles to a school in Guatemala and also sent some along with Gabriela, a teacher from Uruguay who stayed with Mrs. Snyder for two weeks.

The South Eastern School District is creating an advisory board composed of students, teachers, and parents to assist in menu planning.



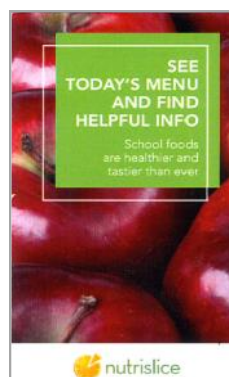
