KAPINOS NOMINATED FOR KEYSTONE RECOGNITION



South Eastern Middle School teacher Joanna Kapinos, recently attended the PAECT Keystone Technology Innovators Summit held at Shippensburg University. Each school principal in Pennsylvania is invited to nominate a teacher for Keystone recognition and nominees may apply to attend the Summit. Joanna was chosen through a portfolio based application. Attendees are chosen based on their demonstrated passion for education and technology. They are creative, innovative teachers who embrace best practices and technology integration in their schools. Keystones advocate the use of technology as a transformative tool to nurture the intellect, innovation, and imagination of students.

The Summit is a weeklong event where teachers spend time working in cohorts, attending pedagogical and technology driven workshops, and building their personal learning networks (PLN). The KTI Summit is organized by the Pennsylvania Association for Educational Technology and Communications (PAECT).

SESD STUDENT FLU VACCINE AVAILABLE

Flu Vaccines - (Injections only - see below)

October 5, 2016 (during the school day) at SESD school buildings
Flu vaccines (injections) are recommended for ages 6 months and older, and are considered effective for preventing the flu. Recently, the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices voted to not recommend the use of the nasal spray in 2016, due to it not being effective in preventing the flu.

Parent consent is required and due by September 23rd.

Consent forms were sent home with students. If you did not receive a form, you may contact the nurse at the building where your child attends school.

SESD will be participating in the Health Hero Program. Every healthy student is eligible to receive flu vaccines regardless of insurance coverage.

VOLUNTEERING IN THE SCHOOLS

Parents/guardians who work with children within the school district in a volunteer capacity must complete specific paperwork and obtain set clearances, as required by law. Please visit the district website at www.sesdweb.net and click on **Volunteering In our Schools** for all of the information.

Paperwork must be submitted to the Administration Building in order for you to be approved to begin volunteering at one of our district schools. Parent/guardians must volunteer at least once a year for their clearances to remain active. New clearances will need to be obtained every 5 years; this is a new requirement.

REGULATIONS FOR VISITING SESD SCHOOLS

For the safety and security of our students:

Parents/guardians are welcome and are urged to visit our schools. Simply call the school office at least twenty four hours in advance to make an appointment with the teacher or administrator with whom you wish to meet. A mutually convenient appointment will be scheduled.

All visitors must sign in at the school office where they will receive a visitor's badge in exchange for a Photo ID. The Photo ID will be returned once the visitor has signed-out and turned in the visitor's badge. Failure to comply with sign in procedures may result in trespassing charges.
